

# FAMILY IS BETTER

Why we aim to promote a better way for orphan care to places of worship.



## THE PROBLEM

### WHAT WE ARE TRYING TO SOLVE...AND WHY

Good-hearted churches and individuals are unknowingly supporting and funding an orphan care structure that is damaging children and breaking up families.

#### Orphanages are not the best place for kids.

Institutional care leads to developmental delays, societal impact, and a repeated cycle of brokenness. For example, a recent study showed that almost 50% of parents in Ukraine who had their babies placed in orphanages had grown up in institutions themselves.<sup>1</sup>

#### Most of the children in orphanages are not orphans.

Approximately 80% of children in institutions have at least one living parent. <sup>2</sup> The main cause for family separation is poverty. In addition, orphanages have become their own industry...and more children means more money for the institutions.

#### Christians are the primary funders of privately run orphanages worldwide.

A recent study shows that U.S. Christians give approximately \$2.5 billion a year to orphanages around the world. For example, in Sonora, Mexico, there are 26 private orphanages, primarily funded from U.S. Christian churches. However, it's more cost-effective to care for children in families. On average, family care costs 5-8 times less than institutional care. In addition, church mission trips and orphanage visitations promote orphanage growth.

The research is clear: family is better. Our vision is to promote a better way of orphan care to churches and people of faith...because every child deserves a family.
